18. Chaplain and Moral Welfare. A Protestant Chaplain was not available to the Command during the period 9-20 July due to the transfer of the Battalion Chaplain without a contact relief. During the period 20-31 July a total of 15 Protestant services were conducted with a total attendance of 436 personnel. Poman Catholic Masses were celebrated for the Battalion by the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marines Chaplain. The Battalion Chaplain also conducted services at the Pegimental Padio Relay Station (Hill 950), and the CAC "O" HQ in KHE SANH Village for personnel attached to the three CAP units. Three orientation lectures were presented to approximately 70 men. Approximately 80 Bibles were distributed, in addition to tracts and other literature. Counselling cases numbered 12.
